TRAILER BRAKE VALVE ADJUSTMENTS AND TESTS

A) PRECONDITIONS:

- a) Trailer attached to tractor
- b) Trailer brakes in perfect condition
- c) Road surface clean and dry tar or concrete
- d) Trailer carriers no load
- Restrict movement of tractor brake pedals so that tractor brakes do not operate.
- 2) Select I. gear low range and drive tractor (half throttle).
- 3) Press hard on TBV button and while pressing adjust the Pmax adjustment on TBV until the braked wheels on trailer have locked, then turn in $\frac{1}{2}$ a turn and lock adjustment.

B) TO AJUST TBV WITHOUT TRAILER AVAILABLE:

NOTE: Obtain maximum brake pressure specifications from trailer manufacturer.

Attach pressure gauge 0 - 25 MPa range. Start tractor, set throttle to 1500 rpm. Press hard on TBV button and set P max to required pressure.
